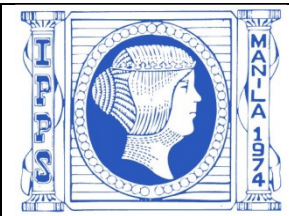

21.	<b>54 (Pair)</b> – Used. Horizontal pair. Right stamp cut into on right side. Very fresh colour and decent perfs for this issue. Any of the early issues are difficult to find used in multiples.	15.00	
22.	<b>58</b> – Used. Partial INTENDENCIA rectangular boxed cancel. Stamp centred top right with commonly found rough perfs. Fresh colour. Very scarce usage	20.00	
23.	<b>70</b> – Mint (OG, HR). Generally well centred with very fresh appearance. Commonly found rough perfs for this issue. Tiny black spot to left of eye mentioned for accuracy. 200m Rose (#69) included as comparison. Scarce and seldom offered. Scott Cat \$350.	150.00	
24.	<b>77</b> – Used. Town Crown Cancel from Culion, Calamines (now Palawan). Good colour and decent base stamp. Nice partial cancel and scarce usage.	20.00	
25.	<b>77 (B/10)</b> – Used (HR). Large block with Official Cancel, two strikes. Rounded bottom left corner on bottom left stamp. Minor toning on reverse showing through on the odd perfs. Commonly found rough perfs. Very scarce in such a large multiple.	60.00	
26.	<b>78-81, 88</b> – Used. 8 Singles and 1 B/4 all with Town Crown Cancels. Very clear Majayjay (Laguna), Mulanay (Tayabas), Ap arri (Cagayan), Camiling (Tarlac), Badajoz (Romblon). Odd faults expected. Scarce usage and hard to find moreso with clear strikes.	120.00

43.	<b>95 (B/6) ERROR</b> – Mint (NG). <b>Sidewase Surcharge</b> . Base stamps well centred with rich colour, but some foxing noted. Minor toning around perfs mainly on top, with bottom left corner cut into slightly and bottom right stamp with perf faults. All stamps with Sideways Surcharge. Very unusual and scarce in larger multiples. Lovely show piece.	60.00	
44.	<b>96 (B/4)</b> – Mint (OG, NH). Generally well centred base stamp with good colour. Nicely struck surcharges making this a lovely looking block. Signed (handstamp) A Roig on reverse.	10.00

49.	<b>98 (x2)</b> – Used. Horizontal pair tied with clear Rectangular Boxed 'CERTIF' Registration cancel. Good colour and generally good perfs. Very nice looking pair with scarce postal usage.	10.00	
50.	<b>99 ERROR</b> – Used. <b>Inverted Surcharge</b> . Base stamp centred low, with very good colour. Commonly found rough or blunt perfs. Nicely struck surcharge. Two partial large Certificado cancels.	15.00	
51.	<b>99 ERROR</b> – Used. <b>Inverted Surcharge</b> . Base stamp centred low, with fresh colour. Rounded perfs on top left corner. Light partial Correos – Manila CDS. Nice looking stamp.	15.00

91.	<p><b>76, 82</b> – Cover from Manila to La Louvier, Belgium. Stamps tied with Correos – 29 Jan 1888 – Manila CDS. French Paquebot 6 Feb 1888 Transit cancel on front. La Louvier – 28 Feb 1888 receiving backstamp on reverse. Very minor tone spots on front noted for accuracy, otherwise a fine looking cover. Scarce combination.</p>	150.00	
92.	<p><b>76, 139</b> – Cover from Manila to Toronto, Canada. Stamps tied with Parrilla Cancel with 'Correos – 2 Jan 1889 – Manila CDS alongside.
