Once in England there is a 'Registered/GPO Dec 17 57' oval red pmk applied on front of official registration, this being applied in cases when the PO thought valuables were inside. An extremely rare example of this application, particularly for mail originating from the Far East in the route Manila-Singapore, and the only stampless of the Philippines where registration service applies at some point on the way upon destination. Normal edge wear and somewhat dirty appearance. Possibly unique.</p>	300.00
