

**TERMS OF AUCTION**

**SELLERS**

- 1) No lotting fees or commission on any sold lots is charged to the Seller.
- 2) Sellers should provide complete lot description information and a minimum (Starting) bid when submitting material to the auctioneer.
- 3) The auctioneer will attempt to accurately describe each lot but is not to be held responsible for errors and omissions.
- 4) All unsold lots will be returned to the Sellers at the close of each auction, unless otherwise instructed.
- 5) Material is to be received by the auctioneer no later than January 31 and July 30 to ensure inclusion in the March and September auctions respectively.
- 6) Send material with lot descriptions and recommended Starting Bids to Nigel Gooding (see address below).
- 7) Payment for sold lots is sent approximately four (4) weeks after the auction close date.

**BUYERS**

- 1) Bidding shall be in U.S. dollars.
- 2) The minimum bid is the "Starting Bid", and no bids below the Starting Bid will be accepted.
- 3) Bidding shall only be accepted in whole dollar values (no cents) only, and any bids with cents will be rounded down up to the nearest dollar.
- 4) Bidding increments are as follows: \$1 for bids up to \$99; and \$5 for bids \$100 and higher.
- 5) All lots will be sold to the highest bidder at ONE BIDDING INCREMENT OVER THE SECOND HIGHEST BID (the result referred to as the "Winning Bid").
- 6) In the event of a tie bid, the bid with the earliest postal date or email date shall be deemed the Winning Bid.
- 7) The auctioneer's decision shall be final.
- 8) The auctioneer reserves the right to withdraw any lot.
- 9) All Catalogue numbers are Scott unless otherwise noted. Other references include: "W" numbers are from Warren (1967) or Lehmann and Lueck (1993), as amended; and forgery numbers, such as "21F1" are from Gooding (2006).
- 10) Bids may be lodged using the online bidding form on the IPPS Auction website. Alternatively, bids can be submitted by regular mail or by email. Your name and address must be provided and readable to be accepted. No telephone bids will be accepted.
- 11) A confirmation email will be sent for all email bids received. If no confirmation email has been received, the bidder is responsible for making contact to the auctioneer to confirm receipt of bids.
- 12) No bids shall be accepted later than the closing date and time.
- 13) A "winner take all" lot is awarded only when that Winning Bid exceeds the sum total of Winning Bids of all individual lots.
- 14) Successful bidders will be invoiced for successful bids, including a 10% buyers fee to IPPS and postage and handling with the following minimum charges: \$1.00 in the UK; \$2.00 across Europe; and \$3.00 for USA and rest of world.
- 15) Lots will be mailed from the UK and sent First Class (UK Buyers) or Regular Airmail (all other Buyers excluding Philippines). All mailing to the Philippines will only be sent via Registered Post. For all other countries, where the total purchase is over \$100.00, the lots will be mailed by Registered Post, incurring an additional charge on top of normal postage of GBP £4.95 (converted to US dollars at time of mailing).
- 16) IPPS is not responsible for loss of postage unless sent by Registered Post.
- 17) Payment is due within 10 days after receipt of invoice. The invoice will detail payment options which include: check, money order or Paypal (via the link on the IPPS Auction website). No cash payments accepted. Check and money order payments to be made to the IPPS.
- 18) Lots incorrectly described may be returned within 5 days of receipt, and a refund will be provided. All other lots cannot be returned for any reason.
- 19) The placing of a bid constitutes acceptance of the above terms.



I have seen two copies of this issue and both have ‘blind’ perf holes causing letters to be partially incomplete. Very scarce and one of the earlier SB&Co perfins.	100.00
