

1931 "REPRINT" IMPERFORATE ISSUE

Lacking access to the Lambert imperforates, the philatelic community requested that the U.S. Bureau of Engraving and Printing issue additional imperforates. This occurred in 1931, in shades distinct from the 1925 issue.
