Cebu, Cebu to United States, Jan. 31, 1928. Rec. Feb. 25th.
4c First Class Rate each ounce, 20c Registration fee. (Mute Bullseye killer)



Manila to United States, March 8, 1929. Rec. April 8th.
4c First Class Rate each ounce, 20c Registration fee. (Mute Circled-Star killer)
"Theta" var., pos 1 on cover; "Dot on Flag" var., pos. 3 on cover

These covers show the two kinds of mute registry killers used during the 1920s and early 1930s. Generally struck in black ink, a few examples can be found in red or violet ink. Starting around 1935, the post office employed the seven line wavy-line killer, and in 1937 changed to the three line wavy-line killer.
