Three sheets with double impression of center were printed, each of a different type. **Type I**: parallel impressions, about 2 mm apart; **Type II**: parallel impressions, about 3 mm apart; **Type III**: slightly askew impressions about 1 mm apart. There were fifty varieties of the **Type III** created, and theoretically the position of each stamp in the sheet may be determined by the relative positions of the two impressions of the center. The three **Type III** examples here show the rotation of the two impressions in the sheet, with (1) one impression about .7 mm to the left of the other, (2) the two impressions nearly parallel, with one only slightly to the right of the other, (3) one impression about 1.6 mm to the right of the other, with little vertical separation between the impressions. From the 150 stamps printed, there are approximately *Twenty-Five Examples Recorded*.
