## **18C BROWN OFFICIAL POSTAL HISTORY PERFORATION ERROR ON COVER**

In 1990, a previously unreported error was discovered on the Legislative Palace issue, an extra row of vertical perforations through the stamp. A complete sheet was discovered showing the additional row of vertical perforations through the third (or central) row of stamps on the sheet. It was surmised additional examples of the error existed based on the statement of early authors that multiple sheets of the stamps were sometimes perforated simultaneously. This cover was subsequently discovered, establishing at least two sheets were perforated at the time the error was made, as the error on cover is identical to the discovered sheet. No other examples of the error have been recorded.
