

SMALL COMMONWEALTH - 1 Peso ORANGE & BLACK

Misamis, Occidental Misamis to Dunedin, New Zealand Nov. 20, 1940. 18c. Foreign First Class Rate, 21-40g. Special Air Rate, P1.40 each 15 grams or less = P2.98 (overpaid by 2c.)

(This air rate applied only to New Zealand. The rate was announced in Circular 17 on Aug. 5, 1940, along with another rate of P1.14/15g, which was used only for airmail to New Caledonia.)



Manila to Sweden, via Hong Kong, Dec. 16, 1939. Victoria, HK transit, Dec. 19. 12c. Foreign First Class, 36c./5g Air. (4c. overpaid). Hong Kong censor.

1 PESO BISECT
Iloilo, Iloilo to St. Gallen, Switzerland, Oct. 23, 1940. 12c. Foreign First Class, 1-20g, P1.60 "Two Ocean" Airmail to Europe via US, 1-15g

BISECT of both a Large and Small Commonwealth 1 Peso stamp, joined. Made to either defraud postal authorities, or to create a postal rarity.
