Postally Used  
 Saigon, Cochinchina  
 cds, April 6, 1883

During the 1880s, several French paquebots visited Manila. Letters which were hand-carried to the ship in Manila Harbor, would move outside the Philippine postal system. One of the common French paquebot routes was via Saigon (Cochinchina under French control at the time.) The mail would have been cancelled in Saigon upon arrival.
