(Juan Mencarini (1896) listed the stamp. Galvez (1900) listed the stamp, stating it was issued in 1883. Bartels (1904) listed it as a stamp of doubtful status. L. Hanciau (1905) discussed the stamp and indicated it was printed in error. Peter Harradine (1987) listed the stamp.)



Manila to Havana, Cuba, May 26, 1884
Black One Real on 2 4/8c Ultramarine postage + Red One Real on 12 4/8c Gray revenue
tied to cover by Colonial Parilla cancel
25c double weight rate to Spanish colony, 1/2-1 oz.
