

Black One Real on 2 4/8c Ultramarine Postage (1882) (APS Cert.)

Six Examples Recorded

(Juan Mencarini (1896) listed the stamp. Galvez (1900) listed the stamp, stating it was issued in 1883. Bartels (1904) listed it as a stamp of doubtful status. L. Hanciau (1905) discussed the stamp and indicated it was printed in error. Peter Harradine (1987) listed the stamp.)



Manila to **Havana**, **Cuba**, May 26, 1884

Black One Real on 2 4/8c Ultramarine postage + Red One Real on 12 4/8c Gray revenue tied to cover by Colonial Parilla cancel

25c double weight rate to Spanish colony, ½-1 oz.
