Over 60,000 exhibit pages (4,000 frames), showing exhibits of many countries and topics, will be present. Philippine exhibitors could win the Eugene A. Garrett Exhibit Award. A special 16-page Philippine exhibit frame will be available for collectors, representing stamps and covers of all periods, from Spanish to Republic.
